TOPICAL AREAS FOR WORKSHOPS AND PRESENTATIONS

- A. Guardianship/Forced Treatment
- B. Recovery/Alternatives to Medical Model Treatment
- C. Advocacy and Legal Strategies for Challenging Times

- Opportunities for participants to develop new skills and/or replicate a successful program.
- Clear outline of the purpose and learning objectives of the presentation.
- Opportunities for engaging attendees.
- Relevance to cultural minorities and other unserved and underserved populations
