



Olanzapine (Zyprexa) by Eli Lilly.

My purpose in making this FOIA request is to obtain copies of documentation submitted to the FDA by Eli Lilly that detailed the results of all clinical testing of olanzapine, including serious adverse events, suicides, and numbers of trial subjects who dropped out during clinical testing.

As a reporter on assignment for the Boston Globe, I make this request in the public interest and request a fee waiver. However, if the fees are not waived and they do not exceed \$75, I would be grateful if you would send me copies of the documents along with your statement of search and copying charges.
