**ORDER FINDING ADMINISTRATIVE RULE 37.7 CONDITIONS HAVE
BEEN MET TO MAKE THE GUARDIANSHIP FILE PUBLIC**


A hearing was held on September 15, 2014, to determine whether the Administrative Rule 37.7 conditions for making the above-captioned guardianship file public are met, and whether the file should be made public. Bret Byron Bohn appeared at the hearing and testified that he wants the file to be made public. He testified he consulted with his attorney in making the decision.

The Court considered the risk of injury to individuals and individual privacy rights and interests in determining the file should be made public, at the request of Mr. Bohn. The guardianship did not involve proprietary business information, the deliberative process, or public safety.

The Court finds it is appropriate to give Mr. Bohn seven (7) days to decide and notify the court in writing if he wants selected portions of the medical records and other personal information to be withheld from disclosure to protect his privacy. If he decides that he does, he should be given an additional thirty (30)

days to review the file and notify the Court regarding which items he would like to remain confidential.


