




The problematic nature of this language was addressed at page 4 of D.G.'s Reply Brief and noted at oral argument.<sup>4</sup>


Tracking AS 47.30.710(b), possible replacement language could be, "It is ordered that Respondent be hospitalized for further evaluation."<sup>5</sup>
