
SEROQUEL Mania Submission Update: J. Mullen

J. Mullen provided a high level overview of the results of the adjunct (Trials 099 and 0100) and monotherapy (0104 and 0105) clinical trials and proposed sNDA submission timelines.

SEROQUEL global submission team is meeting in the US the week of October 28th to review the CSRs and summary documents. Team will continue finalization of the documents from November 11th through to November 22nd. Scheduled regulatory handover of last clinical contribution is December 6th. Scheduled sNDA submission date is December 31st.

It was agreed that there would be a SEROQUEL submission update at a future TALT meeting prior to regulatory handover.
