IMPLEMENTATION OF AUGUST 24, 2020 ORDER

In its August 24, 2020 Order in the above captioned case, this Court:

- (a) directed Dr. Gøtzsche to submit a proposed form of notice to be sent to the respondents,
- (b) directed Dr. Gøtzsche to propose a mechanism whereby the Court provides a transcriber with the audio recordings and the transcriber produces transcripts that do not contain identifiers of the respondent, and
- (c) asked whether Dr. Gøtzsche wanted access to the Alaska Psychiatric Institute (API) files for the respondents.

These will be addressed in turn.

A. Form of Notice

Dr. Gøtzsche has attached a proposed form of notice hereto.

B. Transcription

Dr. Gøtzsche has arranged with Georgi Haynes of H&M Reporting for the Court Clerk to directly provide her with the recordings so she may prepare the redacted transcripts for transmittal to counsel. This Court's August 24, 2020 Order has been


C. API Records



Danish researcher Dr. Peter. Gøtzsche has requested a copy of 30 consecutive court files and hearing transcripts of cases where a Petition for Court Approval of Administration of Psychotropic Medication was filed under Alaska Statutes 47.30.839 in order to conduct a study of whether:

1. The petitions comply with legal requirements.
2. Information is provided that documents that the patient cannot provide informed consent.
3. Information about the psychiatric drugs the patient takes or will be forced to take is accurate.
4. A less intrusive alternative is available.
5. The combination of drugs the patient takes is safe.
6. The arguments for using force are reasonable and documented.
7. The patients' rights have been respected.
8. There are striking similarities from case to case considering that patients are different.

The Court's ruling will also be noted.

All personally identifying information will be blacked out before providing Dr. Gøtzsche with your file, but YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO OBJECT to Dr. Gøtzsche receiving your court information by signing and returning the below form to the Clerk's Office within 30 days of the date of this Notice.
