As required, before asking the Ombudsman's Office for assistance we are appealing DHSS/ Behavioral Health's decision not to answer the following two questions.

- 1. Does Providence Hospital's (Anchorage) single point of entry for psychiatric patients have to abide by and comply with AS47.30.847 (Psychiatric patients' grievance procedure statute).
- 2. Does Providence Hospital's (Anchorage) single point of entry for psychiatric patients have to follow Behavioral Health's 4 pages of requirements for grantee grievance procedures.

I filed a grievance with Providence. Their attorney stated Providence's single point of entry does not have to follow AS47.30.847 and does not have to allow patients an appeal process when filing a grievance and also does not have to give a written copy of the grievance procedure to patients.

Please answer my request for information within ten days. (Don't confuse the single point of entry with the crisis treatment center.)
