Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Relator previously provided defendant with copies of the DRUGDEX monographs for the prescriptions identified in (a) paragraph 24 of the Complaint in this matter, Docket No. 1, and (b) Docket Nos. 46-1, 46-2, and 46-3 (Currently Identified Prescriptions). In addition, the location of a copy of the DRUGDEX Consult, Recommendation, Evidence and Efficacy Ratings is provided below. Relator is also providing below the location of copies of American Hospital Formulary Service Drug Information (AHFS) monographs for the Currently Identified Prescriptions.

With respect to the United States Pharmacopeia—Drug Information (or its successor publications), until recently *Relator* believed that publication had been discontinued and there was no successor. However, it has recently come to *Relator's* attention that DrugPoints, currently published by Truvex, previously published by Thomson Reuters, may be the successor publication. Unfortunately, the publisher has heretofore not been able to provide documentation to demonstrate this. Despite the uncertainty over DrugPoints being the successor publication to United States Pharmacopeia—Drug Information, the location of copies of DrugPoints monographs for the Currently Identified Prescriptions is also provided provided below, along with Appendix A, Strength of Recommendation and Evidence.
